



Child Safeguarding Statement: Campa Craic

1. Service Information

Campa Craic provides seasonal multi-activity summer camps for children aged 4–12 years. Our activities include sports, arts and crafts, cooking and team-building exercises. We operate in community centres, schools, and sports parks. We believe that the best interests of the child are paramount, and we are committed to providing a safe environment for all participants.

2. Risk Assessment

We have carried out an assessment of any potential for harm to a child while attending our camps. Below is a list of the areas of risk identified and the procedures for managing these risks:

Risk Identified	Procedure in place to manage risk
Risk of harm by a staff member.	All staff are Garda Vetted, references are checked, and have undergone Child Safeguarding Training.t
Risk of harm by another child.	We maintain strict adult-to-child ratios (1:18) and implement a clear Anti-Bullying and Code of Behavior policy.
Risk of harm during drop-off/pick-up.	Pick Up and Drop Off points are secure and safe from car parks. Parents must approach the collection zone by foot and children are only released to authorized adults.
Risk of harm through digital media.	Clear policy on photography/video; no unauthorized social media posting by staff.
Injury during activities.	All venues are risk-assessed daily; coaches are First Aid trained.
